Process for Registering and Selecting a Remote Tutoring Session at the Writing Place

To make an appointment at the Writing Place, go to <https://bhcc.mywconline.com>.

Be sure the schedule selected is **Writing Place Schedule- March 30th -May 14th**.

Once you login to our system, you will have two options for tutoring:

1. Option 1 - E-tutoring option is a paper submission option.

- Students select an "appointment" and attach a paper, as well as an assignment if available, for the tutor.
- Students should expect a response from a tutor within 48 hours of the day and time of the appointment.
- This is an asynchronous option, which means the student and tutor do not meet at a designated time to discuss the paper.

2. Option 2 - Online option is an online synchronous (in real time) tutoring session.

- Students should attach their paper and an assignment, if available, for the tutor when making the appointment.
- Students have a video option, chat board if web cams and/or microphones are not available, and a shared white board for which papers can be uploaded and discussed. To access all of these features easily, use Google Chrome as your browser.
- This is a synchronous option, which means the student and tutor meet online at the designated time of the appointment to review a paper.

Please note: Some tutors are designated for e-tutoring only or online only. Some tutors offer both e-tutoring and online options. If you select a tutor who offers both options, you will need to select one of the tutoring options.
