**Date Established:** Spring 2020

**Eligibility:** Students who are admitted to the BHCC ADN program and opt-in to the College Partnership RN to BSN Transfer Agreement are eligible for provisional admission to the RN-BSN program at Emmanuel College. Acceptance to the RN-BSN program is contingent upon the following:

- A. Successful completion of the BHCC ADN program as evidenced by an official transcript reflecting a conferred ADN degree
- B. Current valid Massachusetts RN license
