Dear Student,

This criteria checklist is for you to keep a personal record of the steps you have completed and documents you have submitted towards applying for the Culinary Arts Program.

Admissions Information:

Admission to the **Culinary Arts Program is selective due to limited seat availability.** Attending a mandatory information session early in the application process will help you learn about all the requirements to plan ahead. Please contact the Admissions and Recruitment Office to clarify the application process, review your completed requirements or missing requirements and remaining documents needed before the application deadline. To increase your chance to receive a seat in the program, it is recommended that applicants apply for the priority deadline. Admissions will continue to review applications after the priority deadline on a seat available basis. There is no guarantee space in the program will be available after the priority deadline.

Important Information for International Applicants:

- International applicants, who need to apply for an F-1 visa in their home country, should apply to the program <u>no later than</u> the priority deadline of May 1, 2023.
- International Applicants who are in the United States with valid F1 status can apply for the program before
 either deadline. It is recommended that you complete the admissions requirements by May 1st as this
 program has limited seats that might be filled after the first deadline. Admissions decisions will not be issued
 until after the application deadlines and after the review period. You must maintain your F-1 status accordingly.
 If accepted into the program, you will need to request the transfer of your SEVIS record (I-20) to BHCC after the
 decision is issued.
- International applicants who need to apply for a change of visa status in the United States and are currently on a B visa are not eligible for admission into the program until such time as the change of status request is approved

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Additional Program Information

Waitlist Status

Each application cycle (Fall Semester or Spring Semester) a waitlist may be created for Culinary Arts Program applicants, based on space availability in the program. The number of students that are placed on a waitlist changes each semester. Waitlisted students will follow the same process as accepted students and attend the program specific orientation to maintain their place on the waitlist in preparation to fill a vacancy in the program should it become available. The number of students admitted from the waitlist changes with each application cycle. Acceptance off the waitlist is not guaranteed. **Waitlist status is only applicable for acceptance into the current semester the student is applying for.** Students not selected from the waitlist, if interested will need to reapply for consideration of acceptance in a future semester.
