Adult Education, Basic English Language Learning, Intensive English and Academic ELL are all pathways to degree or certificate programs.

Basic English Language Learning (BELL) - Non-credit

Basic ELL is a part-time program for beginner to intermediate students who want to earn a certificate or degree at Bunker Hill, advance at work, or just improve their English skills.

Adult Education (AE) - Non-credit

The Adult Education (AE) offers educational services including free English language and HiSET classes to adults interested in improving their English for work, study, or personal goals.

Intensive English (IE) - Non-credit

Intensive English is a full-time program for students who want to quickly become proficient. IE teaches reading, writing, listening, speaking and grammar, and allows for students to progress in their studies or prepares them for a better job. This program fulfills a 20 hour a week requirement for F-1 visa students.

Academic English Language Learning (AELL) - Credit

AELL offers theme-based courses for intermediate to advanced degree-seeking students. Students who successfully complete the program earn 6 credits toward General Education requirements while studying real-world texts and reading, writing, and speaking about engaging topics.
