Scope and Contents

The Divisions of Administration & Chief Financial Officer record group includes records dating from 1971 to 2019 from multiple BHCC departments affiliated with the financial services, administration, and public relations of the college, including Information Services, Integrated Marketing & Communications, Comptroller, Facilities, Fiscal Affairs, Human Resources, Public Safety, Grants Management, Workforce and Economic Development, and more. The record group documents a range of functions performed by these departments, including internal communications, maintenance and upkeep of the college, engagement with employees and staff, outreach to the public, tracking BHCC's reception in the news, and managing grants and funding. A large number of items in the record group are from the Integrated Marketing & Communications Department and relate to the Midnight Classes coverage in the news from 2009 to 2010. The formats of the materials in the record group are largely textual, including memos and emails, reports, handbooks, flyers, brochures, surveys, agendas, minutes, proposals, and newspaper clippings and articles. A substantial portion of the materials are newspaper articles from the Media Coverage sub-series. In addition to the textual items, other formats include maps and floor plans.

This collection is arranged into 11 series and 14 sub-series.
