Scope and Contents

The Academic Departments record group dates from 1972 to 2018, and it consists of materials from the various academic divisions, departments, and programs at Bunker Hill Community College. The departments represented include English, History and Social Sciences, Math, Nursing, Computer Information Technology, Early Childhood Education, Hospitality, Legal Studies, Public Safety, Office & Information Management, Visual & Media Arts, Science, and Engineering. Although all these departments have records in this group, the bulk of the materials are from the Math Department, the Nurse Education Department, and the Professional Studies Division. These records highlight courses, events, faculty, and projects for each department in addition to communications within and between departments and the college. Topics and items of note are documents on tutoring in the Math Department, laboratory manuals from the Nurse Education Department and Medical Assistant Program, and information on the M.O.V.I.E. Sound Stage Project from the Media Technology Program. The materials in this record group include a variety of textual formats, such as syllabi, course handouts, binders, presentations, newspaper articles, and more.

Arrangement

This collection is arranged into 5 series and 22 sub-series.

The first series includes three sub-series of items dating between 1997 and 2018 with a few undated records. This series contains the records of the Creative Arts Department, which was a department within what is now the Humanities and

Records from these departments include internal communications, flyers advertising to the college community, and course handouts. These records are in textual formats like memos, flyers, pamphlets, reports, and articles.

Series 2: Mathematics, Behavioral, and Social Sciences (RG007.02)

The second series consist of two sub-series with records that date from 1972 to 2013. However, the bulk of these items are from 1974 to 1980. This series includes records from the Behavioral, Social Sciences, and Global Learning Division in addition to the Science, Engineering, and Mathematics Division. These records are specifically from the History and Social Sciences Department and the Mathematics Department. Materials center on the operations of these departments, including internal communications, course materials, meeting items, reports, and tutoring lists. The formats found in this record group are text-based, such as memos, minutes, newsletters, and syllabi.

Series 3: Nurse Education, Medical Imaging, and Respiration Therapy (RG007.03)

The third series include six sub-series, and the dates of these materials range from 1995 to 2017. This record group contains documents from the Health Sciences Division, which includes the Medical Imaging and Radiography Programs, the Medical Assistant Program, Health Care Delivery, and the Nurse Education Department. These records largely consist of program reports and course materials from the nursing and health sciences departments, but there are also communications and publications related to BHCC's programs. The formats of these items are textual and include reports, syllabi, handbooks, flyers, pamphlets, newspaper articles, letters, emails, and binders.

Series 4: Professional Studies (RG007.04)

The fourth series is comprised of nine sub-series, and the materials are dated from 1973 to 2014. This record group includes documents from the Professional Studies Division, which encompasses other departments and programs like the Computer

Information Technology Department, the Early Childhood Education & Human Services Department, the Hospitality Department, the Paralegal and Legal Studies Department, the Public Safety Department, the Office & Information Management Department, the Visual & Media Arts Department, the Media Technology Program, and the Electronics Technology Program. The materials in RG007.04 relate to the operations of the programs through communications, course materials, event programs and agendas, project reports, and informative handouts. Prominent topics include the National Information, Security, and Geospatial Technology Consortium (NISGTC), the Washington Education Project, and the M.O.V.I.E. Sound Stage Project. Formats included are memos, reports, minutes, agendas, reports, flyers, presentations, proposals, newspaper articles, syllabi, and binders.

These materials are largely course documents like syllabi and handouts, with the Science & Engineering Department sub-series including several lab instruction documents.
