## **Scope and Contents**

The Student Scholarships and Student Recognition record group includes materials from 1978 to 2016. These records were created by various departments and employees throughout Bunker Hill Community College, and they are all related to scholarships awarded to students. These scholarships include awards created by the college itself in addition to scholarships awarded to BHCC students from other organizations and institutions. The contents of this record group are primarily official communications between departments and faculty within the college related to scholarships and press releases sent to news outlets recognizing students. In addition to records documenting who won scholarships, there are also materials that highlight the application and decision-making process for BHCC scholarships. The formats of items in this record group are largely textual, including newspaper articles, press releases, memos, and letters. The only non-textual items are photographs of scholarship recipients, some of which are stored in the Photographs record group in 1.1997.2.3, 1.1998.3.6, and 1.1998.3.7.

## **Collection Inventory**

### **Series 1: BHCC Scholarships (RG009.01)**

The first series contains five folders that document the scholarships created and awarded to students by Bunker Hill Community College. These records date from 1990 to 2008, and five scholarships are represented in the materials. The first, the Ralph Radell English-as-a-Second-Language Scholarship, was awarded to students who successfully completed ESL courses. The scholarship was established in memory of Ralph Radell, a professor and the chairperson of the ESL department who worked at BHCC from 1982 to 1996. The second folder contains documents from the BHCC Housing Development Scholarship, which was a scholarship for students living in the Bunker Hill Housing Development in Charlestown. The third folder holds the records of the Cheryl Loring Award/Scholarship—a scholarship established using a donation from Cheryl Loring to help pay one year's tuition for handicapped and disabled students at BHCC. The One Family scholarship in the fourth folder was established by BHCC to help women who formerly experienced homelessness receive an education and was co-sponsored by One Family Inc., a non-profit organization focused on ending homelessness in Massachusetts. The last

folder includes two other scholarships created BHCC's non-profit foundation: The Marguerite I. Munster Memorial Scholarship, which awarded \$250 a semester to a student in the nursing program, and the Charles L. Banino Scholarship, which was a \$500 annual award given to a student selected from the Culinary Arts program at BHCC. The formats of these records are almost all text-based and include memos, letters, newspaper articles, agendas, and presentations. The only other format is photographs of Ralph Radell Scholarship recipients, and they are stored in 1.1997.2.3, 1.1998.3.6, and 1.1998.3.7 of the Photographs record group.

### **Series 2: Non-BHCC Scholarships (RG009.02)**

The second series consists of five folders with contents that date from 1978 to 2016. All the records in this folder relate to scholarships that were created and awarded to BHCC students from external organizations, although BHCC faculty and staff would often choose and submit students for consideration. The first two folders contain materials documenting the Harry S. Truman Scholarship, which was a national scholarship for students in their final year of college interested in public service careers. Many of the Harry S. Truman materials were created by James Whipple, a history professor at BHCC who headed the search committee for the scholarship at the college. The third folder is for the Center for the Study of the Presidency Student Symposium, which was a scholarship program for undergraduate students near the end of their programs who were academically rigorous and interested in the U.S. government and public service. BHCC submitted students to participate in symposiums held yearly by the center. The fourth folder documents the HRSA Scholarships for Disadvantaged Students— a scholarship sponsored by the Health Resources and Services Administration for students in health fields. The final folder contains documents for another scholarship from the Teamsters Local 25 workers' union in Charlestown, Massachusetts. Most of the records in RG009.02 are text-based in format, including news articles, proposals, data, and forms, but there are some photographs associated with the Harry S. Truman Scholarship.

### **Series 3: News and Publicity (RG009.03)**

The third series includes two folders with records that highlight the publicity of BHCC students and their achievements. These materials date from 1994 to 2013, although most of the items are from 1997 to 2004. The first folder contains press releases created by BHCC to recognize students, but there are also some communications between representatives from Marketing and other BHCC parties related to scholarship winners. The second folder documents student accomplishments and achievements that happened during or are related to their time at BHCC, and it includes both press releases created by the college and news articles from various sources. The formats of materials in this record group are largely text-based, such as newspaper/magazine articles, press releases, and memos. However, there are also some photographs of scholarship recipients.
